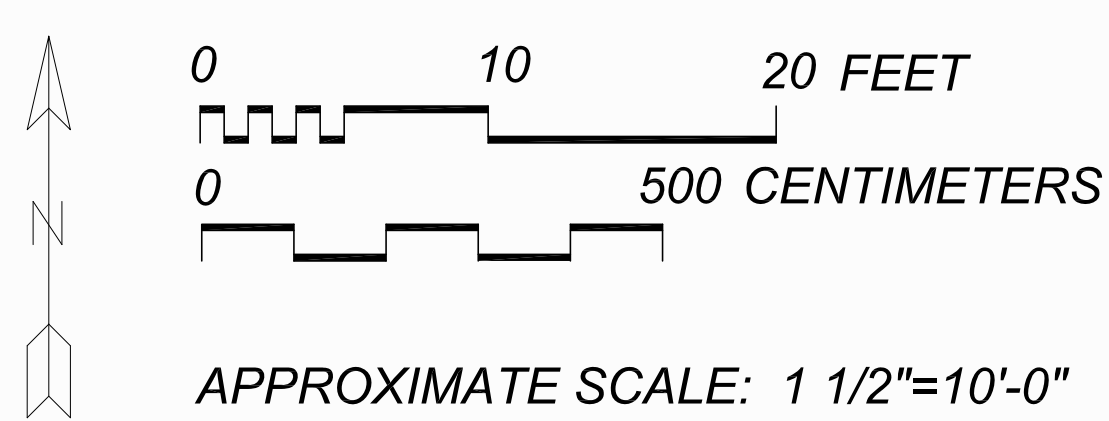


# MOUNT ZION CEMETERY

1975 PLAN PREPARED BY VOLUNTEER WORKERS FROM WESTERN HIGH SCHOOL AND WASHINGTON TECHNICAL INSTITUTE PRIOR TO THE REMOVAL OF MOST GRAVESTONES FOR MAINTENANCE PURPOSES, TO GUIDE THEIR COURT-ORDERED RETURN. THE REMOVED STONES, HOWEVER, HAVE NEVER BEEN RETURNED TO THEIR ORIGINAL LOCATIONS. THE PLAN CONSISTS OF 92 INDIVIDUAL GRID SQUARES EACH REPRESENTING 20 BY 20 FEET OR 400 SQUARE FEET. WITHIN EACH SQUARE, GRAVESTONES AND FAMILY PLOTS ARE DEPICTED AS WELL AS DIMENSIONS TO AND FROM EACH ARTIFICIAL GRID LINE. THE PROPERTY LINE IS NOT DEPICTED. IT APPEARS THAT SECTIONS WERE NOT PREPARED FOR GRID SQUARES CONTAINING NO KNOWN GRAVESITES. THE INDIVIDUAL SECTIONS WERE DIGITIZED AND PIECED TOGETHER BY THE HISTORIC AMERICAN LANDSCAPES SURVEY IN 2008. NO OTHER GRAVESITE PLANS ARE KNOWN TO EXIST. MILL STREET, N.W. IS LOCATED TO THE SOUTH, AND THE FEMALE UNION BAND CEMETERY LIES TO THE WEST.
