

FEMALE UNION BAND CEMETERY

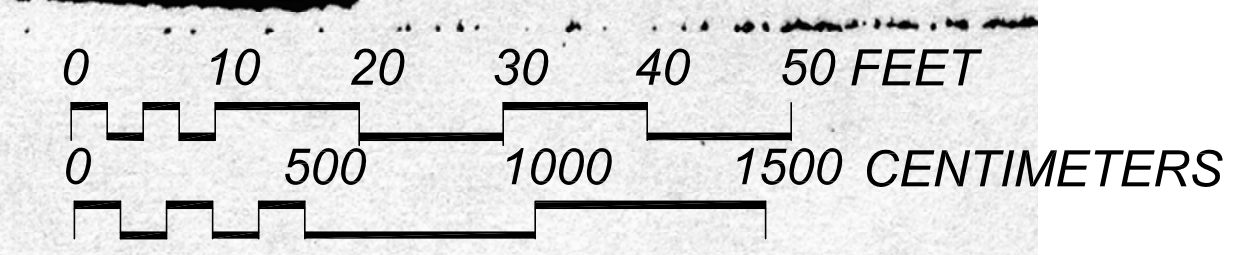
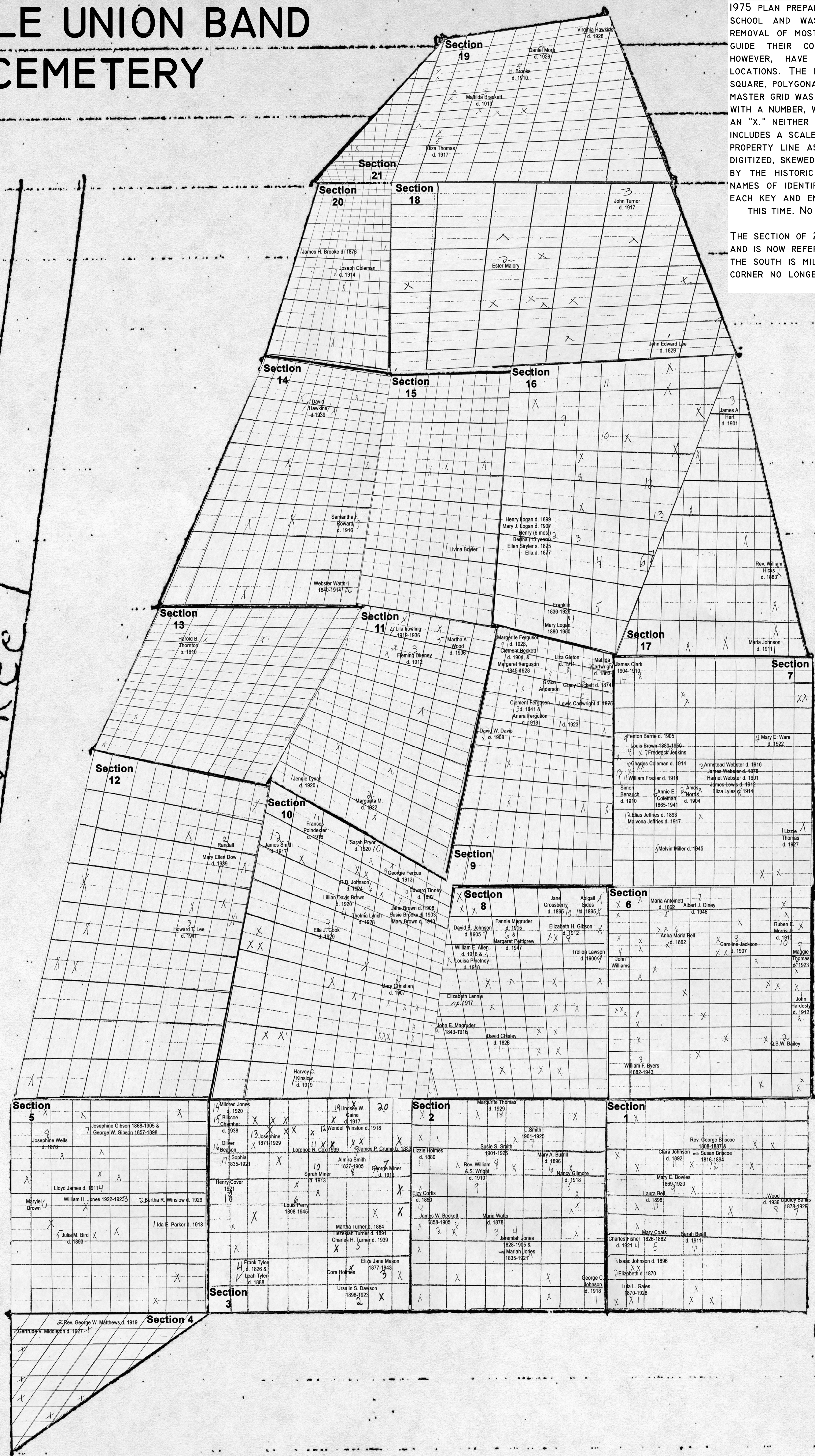
1975 PLAN PREPARED BY VOLUNTEER WORKERS FROM WESTERN HIGH SCHOOL AND WASHINGTON TECHNICAL INSTITUTE PRIOR TO THE REMOVAL OF MOST GRAVESTONES FOR MAINTENANCE PURPOSES, TO GUIDE THEIR COURT-ORDERED RETURN. THE REMOVED STONES, HOWEVER, HAVE NEVER BEEN RETURNED TO THEIR ORIGINAL LOCATIONS. THE PLAN CONSISTS OF 21 SEPARATE AND IRREGULAR SQUARE, POLYGONAL, OR TRIANGULAR SECTIONS FOR WHICH A SQUARE MASTER GRID WAS PREPARED. IDENTIFIED GRAVESITES WERE LABELED WITH A NUMBER, WHILE UNIDENTIFIED GRAVESITES ARE MARKED WITH AN "X." NEITHER THE INDIVIDUAL SECTIONS NOR THE MASTER GRID INCLUDES A SCALE, BUT THE MASTER GRID DOES INCLUDE A CRUDE PROPERTY LINE AS A REFERENCE. THE INDIVIDUAL SECTIONS WERE DIGITIZED, SKEWED TO FIT THE MASTER GRID, AND PIECED TOGETHER BY THE HISTORIC AMERICAN LANDSCAPES SURVEY IN 2008. THE NAMES OF IDENTIFIED GRAVESITES WERE ALSO TRANSFERRED FROM EACH KEY AND ENTERED BESIDE THEIR CORRESPONDING NUMBER AT THIS TIME. NO OTHER GRAVESITE PLANS ARE KNOWN TO EXIST.

THE SECTION OF 27TH STREET TO THE WEST IS NO LONGER IN USE AND IS NOW REFERRED TO AS 27TH STREET R.O.W.. THE ALLEY TO THE SOUTH IS MILL STREET, N.W.. THE GATE AT THE SOUTHEAST CORNER NO LONGER EXISTS. MOUNT ZION CEMETERY LIES TO THE EAST.
