





Will and Testament

Wills Submitted for Probate.
The will of Sarah A. Feast, dated May 7, 1904, filed for probate.



The late Samuel G. Kinsley, who died recently while at the Home Club, Elks' building, 1006 E street, left the furniture and other property contained in his room at the Hotel Lawrence to Miss Sadie Street.

By the terms of the will of Collin B. Crusor, dated March 15 last, and filed for probate, to his sons, William Crusor and Walter Crusor, and his daughter, Pauline Crusor, \$5,000 each is bequeathed, while the remainder of the estate is left to his wife, Annie R. Crusor. Dr. Charles I. West is named executor.

ADDITIONAL BIOGRAPHY

Dr. Crusor was a physician to the Black Georgetown community. He is noted as the attending physician for treating illness and providing comfort at the time of death for many persons interred in the Mount Zion and Female Union Band Society Cemeteries.
